## **Intercessory Prayers of Paul**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Corinthians 1:4-9** God I thank You concerning \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the grace You gave to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ by Christ Jesus, <sup>5</sup> that they were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge, <sup>6</sup> even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in them, <sup>7</sup> so that they come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>8</sup> who will also confirm them to the end, *that they may be* blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> God, You are faithful, by whom they were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

<sup>NKJ</sup> Ephesians 1:15-19 Therefore I also, after I heard of \_\_\_\_\_\_ faith in You Lord Jesus and \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ love for all the saints, <sup>16</sup> will not cease to give thanks for \_\_\_\_\_\_, making mention of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in my prayers: <sup>17</sup> that You Lord God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to \_\_\_\_\_\_ the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Christ, <sup>18</sup> that the eyes of \_\_\_\_\_\_ understanding being enlightened; that \_\_\_\_\_ may know what is the hope of Your calling, what are the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints, <sup>19</sup> and what *is* the exceeding greatness of Your power toward us who believe, according to the working of Your mighty power.

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Ephesians 3:14-21** For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>15</sup> from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, <sup>16</sup> that You would grant \_\_\_\_\_\_, according to the riches of Your glory, to be strengthened with might through You Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup> that Christ may dwell in \_\_\_\_\_\_ heart through faith; that \_\_\_\_\_, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup> may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height -- <sup>19</sup> to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that \_\_\_\_\_ may be filled with all the fullness of You, Lord God. <sup>20</sup> Now to You who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, <sup>21</sup> to You *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

NKJ Philippians 1:3-11 I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, <sup>4</sup> always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy, <sup>5</sup> for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now, <sup>6</sup> being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ; <sup>7</sup> just as it is right for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart, inasmuch as both in my chains and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you all are partakers with me of grace.<sup>8</sup> For God is my witness, how greatly I long for you all with the affection of Jesus Christ.<sup>9</sup> And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, <sup>10</sup> that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, <sup>11</sup> being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

NKJ Colossians 1:3-14 We give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, <sup>4</sup> since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of your love for all the saints; <sup>5</sup> because of the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, of which you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel, <sup>6</sup> which has come to you, as *it has* also in all the world, and is bringing forth fruit, as it is also among you since the day you heard and knew the grace of God in truth; <sup>7</sup> as you also learned from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant, who is a faithful minister of Christ on your behalf, <sup>8</sup> who also declared to us your love in the Spirit.<sup>9</sup> For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; <sup>10</sup> that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; <sup>11</sup> strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; <sup>12</sup> giving thanks to the Father who has gualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.<sup>13</sup> He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Thessalonians 1:2-3** We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers, <sup>3</sup> remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,

**1 Thessalonians 5:23-24** <sup>23</sup> Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>24</sup> He who calls you *is* faithful, who also will do *it*.

**2 Thessalonians 1:11-12** <sup>11</sup> Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of *His* goodness and the work of faith with power, <sup>12</sup> that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

**Philemon 1:4-6** <sup>4</sup> I thank my God, making mention of you always in my prayers, <sup>5</sup> hearing of your love and faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints, <sup>6</sup> that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.
